A warm welcome to our Christmas Concert - it's our favourite concert of the year, and we appreciate you all coming along to join in with the fun. A special thanks to Mrs White & the Heathlands School Choir and Mrs Bennett & the Millfields School Choir for joining us. It's always a busy time of year, especially for those of us with musical children, so we appreciate you all coming along tonight and bringing your young musicians with you.

I believe that Mrs White has already told Mrs Bennett that tonight is a relaxed concert and that the children can sit with the audience during the pieces where they're not singing. Apparently they're also allowed to wear crazy Christmas dress instead of school uniform, possibly inspired by the band member who came dressed as a reindeer last year. I dread to think what the band are dressed in this year.

In order for our younger musicians to get home in time for bed, the first half includes all of the pieces with the choirs - some with the band, some on their own, and some as a massed choir. We've chosen some rare Christmas pieces that the choirs weren't familiar with so they've done brilliantly to learn them all. As you hopefully know these Christmas classics, you are welcome to join in too.

My memory of the band's Christmas Concerts goes back to my first in 1982, when 60+ school-aged musicians & 100+ audience members squeezed into Heathlands School Hall (before it was extended). Shortly after I took over conducting 30 years ago

our concerts moved to West Bergholt Church,

with the band squeezing in between the organ, altar and pews, the latter being crammed full of people until no-

one could move.
We eventually had

to move to bigger venues, with our Christmas Concerts now held either at St Peter ad Vincula in Coggeshall or here at St Botolph's, which is a simply wonderful place to play in.
